Dellandrea for *The Great Canadian Art Fraud Case: The Group of Seven & Tom Thomson Forgeries*, published by Goose Lane Editions.

This highly engaging book is both the dramatic history of the early 1960s Ontario Provincial Police case into the mysterious figures behind the reproduction of the works of Canada’s most famous Ontario based art collectives, and the gripping tale of how through a series of coincidences and dogged investigation in the twenty-first century the author ultimately learned the story of the key players and what happened to them post-event. Full of intrigue and “who-dunnit” suspense as the author follows the paths of the motley players, this book screams to be made into a dramatic film or documentary.

In this, his first published book, Jon Dellandrea has produced a piece of art unto itself, intricately interwoven with full-colour images of the forged artwork and the originals they were purported to represent.
